SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I don't care what you all do on this bill. This is one of the nuttiest discussions I've heard, not because people are not being honest, but you know where you're going to go. But here's something that I will say that I'm watching. If it develops to the point where the skids are greased and the opponents are not given an opportunity to present their case, and I'm an opponent but I'm not going to be speaking, then I will get into it and punish the body for doing that. Fair is fair, even if it is on something that you don't like. I believe what you all did on the State Fair was unfair but I didn't cry. I'm going to get even. That's what old man Kennedy said, don't get mad, get even. And I know how to get even. Some of my younger colleagues don't know, and some people are not mindful of the rules. I'm the one who shouldn't be mindful because I always vote against them, but I'm going to watch and see that in my opinion fairness ought to be the order of the day. But what I really wanted to mention was how puzzled I am by Senator Cunningham saying he cannot answer questions because another job he's got. His first job when he's in this Legislature is to be a senator. He swore. He took an oath up there and I'll bet he said he swears, I affirm. I don't swear. The "Bibble" says don't swear by anything. Let your yea be yea, your nay be nay, anything more than this proceedeth of evil. But he swore, I'm sure. But anyway, he's going to say in the midst of a debate that he can't answer a question because of another job he's got, why that is preposterous. Under the constitution, a senator cannot be called on to answer for what he said during debate in any other forum, any other place. So that's hiding. And if he's got the kind of job where they own him to such an extent that they tell him, you just shut up and be quiet and don't talk about this on the floor of the Legislature, we've got a sellout.
