SENATOR SMITH: Record vote, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: A record vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1549.) 15 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was not successful. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Enrollment and Review reports LB 1017 to Select File, LB 499 to Select File. Senator Raikes, an amendment to be printed to LB 868. (Legislative Journal pages 1550-1551.)

Mr. President, the next motion with respect to LR 11CA, and again it's per the Speaker's direction, Senator Aguilar would move to return the bill for specific amendment, AM3601. (Legislative Journal page 1551.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Aguilar, you're recognized to open on your motion to return LR 11CA for specific amendment. Senator Aguilar.

SENATOR AGUILAR: Thank you, Mr. President and members. What my amendment is going to do is, basically, I'm asking to authorize slot machines within licensed racetrack enclosures, if live thoroughbred horse racing has been conducted at such an enclosure during each of the four years immediately preceding such authorization. Now why I want to do this I think is obvious. You know, everyone knows I have a great concern about Fonner Park. Fonner Park is the racetrack there in Grand Island that I've raved about for years. I talk about it every opportunity I get on the floor of the Legislature. And simply because in Grand Island, Nebraska, we don't look at Fonner Park
