CLERK: Senator Schimek, AM3170,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek.

CLERK: ...I understand you'd like to withdraw, Senator.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Correct.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Schrock, AM3391, I have a note you want to withdraw, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Schrock, AM3537, a note you'd like to withdraw.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, AM3537 withdrawn. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Schrock, AM3571. (Legislative Journal page 1477.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, to open on AM3571.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, thank you for your comments, Senator Preister, and remember it is more blessed to give than to receive. (Laugh) That's my attempt at humor tonight, for what that's worth. I'm going to read this. It's going to take a little time, but bear with me. I think it needs to be entered into the record. From our earlier discussions on this bill, the following sections have been changed as a result of proposals made by Senator Beutler, Senator Chambers, Senator McDonald, Senator Preister, and myself, and I thank the other four senators for their input. Section 5 now incorporates a definition of concentrated animal feeding operation, and an exemption for aquaculture, and states authorization and limitations under a general permit. Section 6 authorizes the administration of an NPDES program, as well as a construction approval and major modification under the Livestock
