Waste Management Act, the Environmental Protection Act, and the rules and regulations adopted by the council. You're going to hear the NPDES throughout this discussion. NPDES stands for National Pollution Discharge Elimination System. Section 10 states that if the department determines that a discharge is more likely than not to occur, an otherwise exempt facility would come under the requirements for inspection and construction approval requirements. Section 11 establishes a minimum fee of \$100 to a maximum fee of \$500 for inspections, and allows the council to consider animal capacity when determining the fee. Section 12 states the requirements for coverage under NPDES permits for large and medium facilities as defined in federal rules. Section 13 is a substantial change to the process, which I will address a little bit later. Section 14 consumes...concerns the nutrient management plan. It states that the plan is a part of the application and must be kept on file at the department. The applicant must also certify to the best of the applicant's knowledge and the belief that the information contained in the application is accurate and that the applicant has the authority under the laws of the state of Nebraska to sign such an application, and the application for construction approval or major modifications must contain information required by rules and regulations in effect on January 1, 2004. Section 15 requires a review of the fees by the department to meet 20 percent of the cost of the program. And there is no annual fee now, but under this program there will become an annual fee provision and it starts in the year 2005 and the fee will be based on beef animals in a feedlot, 10 cents per head annually. Section 19 requires the department to determine that an applicant or permittee is not suited to operate an animal feeding operation if certain conditions are met. The conditions remain as they were in the original bill. The amendment change is "may" to "shall" on line 16, page 29. Section 23 inserts the requirement that the council develop rules and regulations regarding the description of the types of the changes made to the nutrient management plan required to be updated. This section also establishes that if a conflict develops as to the delegation of legislative authority under the Environmental Protection Act and the Livestock Waste Management Act, the Livestock Waste Management Act controls. Going back to Section 13, the process section, a construction approval is a
