The matter can be reviewed between now and next January, and the issues that have been discussed but not resolved perhaps can be discussed and even negotiated among the people who have a strong interest in this, and a better bill can come. But to make this radical change, or drastic change, as it has been described, at the last minute, just to try to get something across, is not sound legislating, in my opinion. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Schrock, followed by nine others.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, it's obvious that we're not going to get this bill accomplished in 30 minutes. And I'm going to defer to the Speaker here. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, would you yield?

SENATOR SCHROCK: It's obvious to me this bill is not going to move in 30 minutes. I laid out what needed to take place. It's your call. Do you want to remove it from the agenda? I don't know what else to do with it at this time.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Schrock. It's...I'll yield to your judgment on whether you think you can get the bill moved. And if you cannot, for the sake of time, it would be probably in the best interest of the body to move on to another bill.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I'll ask you to withdraw the bill from the floor then.

SPEAKER BROMM: If I could, Mr. President, we'll move from LB 32 to the next scheduled piece of legislation.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Speaker Bromm. Thank you, Senator Schrock. We will pass over LB 32, move on to General File, 2004 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 958 was a bill introduced by Senator Foley. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 9 of this
