are...those are hard questions. Those are questions for which there really aren't answers beyond beliefs and faith. In fact, in the court trial that's going on right here in Lincoln there is a question about when does a fetus feel pain, does a fetus feel pain, and there are no definitive studies on that. Nobody really knows. And so Senator Chambers and other religions actually believe that human life does not begin until the birth of that baby, so we have a wide divergence of opinion all across the board, and this bill does attempt to impose one religious belief on everyone. Now I would like to see some protections of those late-term fetuses, those fetuses that are about to become full-blown babies that are going to be born into this world, in which pregnancy is obvious, in which...in which pregnancy has developed to the point where everybody knows there's a pregnancy. I think this particular bill, as written, is going to be very, very, very difficult...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...to interpret and implement and prosecute when you start with the theory that any fetus at any stage of development in the uterus is going to be one of the...one of the standards on which somebody can be prosecuted. I don't know how you can do that. I think it's going to be very, very difficult. The same was true of the bill that we passed, I believe it was last year, Senator Foley. I ended up voting for that bill, but I knew in my heart of hearts that it was going to be a prosecutor's nightmare, particularly for those pregnancies that were at very early stages. So I'm going to be a bit more reluctant here unless we can get some changes...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...in the language of the bill. Thank you.
