Legislature to do, so that I can illustrate what I mean by illogical process, to say up is down, down is up, and this is an...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...an extension of that illogical process by saying inside is outside, and outside is inside. But I want to show you a flaw in this whole thing. An ovum can be fertilized outside the uterus and then be implanted, and if it is implanted properly a pregnancy results. But if, as Senator Maxwell argued, a human being exists at the point of conception, when that spermatozoon fertilizes that ovum and produces a zygote, that is a human being even though it exists outside the womb. But Senator Foley won't touch that. He's not interested in all human beings, neither is Senator Maxwell. What becomes of the human being that Senator Redfield indicates should be protected everywhere? She hasn't even said protect that human being in the laboratory dish, the laboratory vessel, whatever environment outside the womb the fertilization takes place. Why won't they stand up and say that life is as...is vulnerable,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...protect it? Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Friend and Senator Chambers. (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion, Senator Beutler. This will be your third time, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, it is...it is interesting that in the abortion discussion there is a very strict line that's drawn by a great many people based on a concept of when life begins, and once that point is established then everything goes in the same direction based on that concept, with seemingly no departures, except...and the criticism on the other side to...of the other side then is that they are not consistent; that they make exceptions for considerations related to the mother, the woman. And yet, in this very bill Senator Foley has done exactly the same thing. He says it's not his intent to include the mother, and I accept
