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faith, a person, a senator, can have many legislative objectives but not try to achieve all objectives with a single bill. This bill has very clear parameters and protects human life in utero. But I've never said that human life created through other means should not be protected. That's my point. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Foley, have you finished, Senator Foley? Senator Friend, followed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR FRIEND: (Microphone malfunction)...thank you...thank you. Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Mr. President. I was wondering if Senator Chambers would yield to a question please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, would you yield to a question from Senator Friend?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) Senator Friend, if you and I hadn't had so many battles about Rommel and Patton, we wouldn't both be treated the same way. But, yes, I will answer the question.

SENATOR FRIEND: They're turning our mikes off. I don't blame them.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) Yes.

SENATOR FRIEND: Somewhat seriously, I guess, how do...you believe that this law...you just made the statement a few minutes ago that a law like this is unenforceable. Right?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Exactly,...

SENATOR FRIEND: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...the way it's crafted.

SENATOR FRIEND: Okay. Do you believe that we have criminal code out there that law enforcement officials are having difficulty enforcing or often it can be considered that it's almost impossible to enforce? I mean, would you agree with that
