SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right. Now you would not do anything, because I have four full-grown children, none of us would do anything to embarrass our children knowingly.

SENATOR FRIEND: Are you implying that I'm embarrassing one of my children right now?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) I'm asking you a question. Don't be so...

SENATOR FRIEND: No, I would not do anything willingly to embarrass my children.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Now, Senator Friend, let's talk about somebody else's children, somebody who is not...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...as careful for their child as you are of yours and I of mine. And that person, not you or I, would stand on the floor and say that a cell has a body and organs, do you think that guy's children might be embarrassed that their father said that in public?

SENATOR FRIEND: Well, if you'd like to phrase it that way and if everybody, you know, kind of goes in the direction that you believe that that is the direction that this conversation is going, yeah, I think that there would be some embarrassment, but I don't...I'm not sure that I see it that way.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now let me ask you, name me one organ that a cell has.

SENATOR FRIEND: Well, I don't think I can.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Because it has no organs, right?

SENATOR FRIEND: There are living human beings that don't have...
