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of the Legislature, I am trying to...Senator Chambers had pointed out, off the record, of course, I, you know, I didn't write the bill. I didn't. I'm trying to understand where...this is the type of stuff that I used to read about ten years ago, about Senator Chambers and others who would fight this type of stuff, and I said, gosh, I'd like to get in there and just throw something their way. Well, I guess this is my effort. Let's see where it goes. I will have some questions for Senator Chambers, but I guess my feeling is this. We talked about a human being having organs. Let me get right to the question. Would Senator Chambers yield to a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, would you yield?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Of course I will.

SENATOR FRIEND: Oh, thank you. Do you believe that there are...Senator, in your...just your opinion, your philosophy, do you believe there are different forms of human beings?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, no.

SENATOR FRIEND: You don't?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, the way you asked the question.

SENATOR FRIEND: Okay. A good answer, I guess. It's your answer.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) I guess it's good, if I understand your question, I guess.

SENATOR FRIEND: You're playing right in...you're playing right into my trap.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Very good, Mr. Spider.

SENATOR FRIEND: Um...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Carry this fly a little further.
