SPEAKER BROMM: You're right. You're right, Senator Foley. This bill will go behind the other bills on Select File. It will go behind the bills that are returned from Final Reading for specific amendment that are already on Final Reading. It will go behind that with the exception, I'll tell you right now, it's my idea to hold a couple of Final Reading bills that might take a little more time till Wednesday, so I won't put those up ahead of your bill. But I just...I just want you to understand what I'm trying to say and we'll go ahead and do our business, if you're agreeable, but don't plan on us having time on this bill on Tuesday. I just want you to know that.

SENATOR FOLEY: Well, you're being a little bit more definitive than I want you to be, Senator Bromm.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay.

SENATOR FOLEY: I want you to be a little more hopeful...

SPEAKER BROMM: All right.

SENATOR FOLEY: ...that we (laugh) can move some things along more quickly on Tuesday.

SPEAKER BROMM: Well, I'm also practical I think. So, Senator Foley, if you're...are you okay with where we're at and what we're doing, with the agreement and the accord that you and Senator Chambers...

SENATOR FOLEY: With the understanding that the bill will be scheduled for Tuesday and that if we can move things along quickly Tuesday, and I realize there's a lot of work ahead of us Tuesday.

SPEAKER BROMM: All right.

SENATOR FOLEY: It will be a difficult day, but we'll all be in good spirits and we'll work hard to move bills quickly and perhaps we may get back to this bill Tuesday.
