be turned aside. There is no negotiating, no bargaining, nothing. The thread is to be cut. Now here's where we are. There are still 48 of you against me. See what you can do to me in these last three days. Start by giving Senator Foley cloture. Give him what he wants, and think about the consequences. I've thought about what I will do. So my mood has nothing to do with what I'm going to do when I feel it's necessary. What do I get out of this deal that's being cut? Nothing. I didn't ask that my DNA bill be put on the list. I told the Speaker I will not put mine on the list of those bills that we would cover, and I'm not aware of a great amount of controversy surrounding my bill. But as one who could be considered one of the architects of the deal, I was not going to get anything out of it. All that I got out of it was having been made to take low by pulling all of my amendments and I get nothing in return, and I didn't ask for anything in return. But I'm not going to let Senator Foley have it all his way. You all are going to help...have to help Senator Foley crush me today. But I assure you, like the Phoenix, come Tuesday I will be back. And unlike General MacArthur, there will not be a long hiatus. You will see me Tuesday when you're here. And I'm going to get copies of all the bills that are on the agenda, and I will have something to say on every bill that comes up. I'm promising you all that and you all don't want me to make promises that I don't keep. Earlier in the session, I gave examples and then I backed away because you all don't believe me. Now I'm not the one for you to try to prevail on to do anything. You need to talk to that tall gentleman back there. He wants everything. Well, I'm going to put us in a position today for him to get it. I'm going to take my amendments. He's going to offer his motion for cloture at whatever point, and if there are enough of you all to give him what he wants, give it to him.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not going to get mad, but I assure you I'm going to get even. Now consider whether you're being intelligent or stupid. If you give him cloture, you're not giving him anything other than the stick to hit me with because his bill won't go anywhere after it's over there, however it gets there. But if you send it over there on his terms, you all
