CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Debate does cease. Senator Thompson, you're recognized to close. Is Senator Thompson present? I do not...here she comes. Senator Thompson, you're recognized to close on your motion to cease debate. She waives the opportunity to close. Mr. Clerk, read the question before the body. Senator Beutler, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Have a call of the house, roll call vote, regular order.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, those opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Schimek, Senator Jones, Senator Louden, Senator Bourne, Senator Kruse. Senator Jones.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Kruse, Senator Louden. All members are present. Members, the issue we are voting on is the reconsideration motion of Senator Thompson on AM3636 to the Baker amendment. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll in regular order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1587-1588.) 25 ayes, 22 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is successful...the motion is successful to reconsider the amendment. Senator Beutler, you'd be recognized on the reconsideration of the amendment.
