SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the opening on AM3482. I see no discussion. Senator Stuhr, you're recognized to close, and she waives. The question then is the adoption of AM3482. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Stuhr's amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 1097A to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is to advance LB 1097A to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Members, before we go to messages and announcements, we will make a slight change to the agenda, and we'll move LB 1207 to follow LB 499. In that same category, so the next bill after messages and announcements will be LB 485. Mr. Clerk, do you have any messages or announcements?
