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auditor. Any amount that would otherwise be deposited into the Department of...Enforcement, or these two, in excess of this amount, goes into the General Fund. So it depends on how much you get, capped at \$500,000 and at 10 percent, whichever is lower.

SENATOR BEUTLER: (Inaudible.)

SENATOR LANDIS: That's '04-05. For Fiscal Year '05-06, all proceeds to the Department of...those funds, shall be appropriated to the Department of Revenue for the purposes of employing investigators, agents, and auditors, otherwise increasing personnel, for enforcement of the Revenue Act. For Fiscal Year 2005-06, all proceeds in the enforcement shall be for acquiring lists, software, programming, computer programs. For fiscal years after Fiscal Year 2005-06, 20 percent of all...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...proceeds received during the previous calendar year due to the efforts of the auditors and investigators hired pursuant to the subdivision--not the whole code, just these people--not to exceed \$750,000, shall be deposited in the Department of Revenue Enforcement Fund, for purposes of employing investigators, so that the ongoing cost of these people hired out of the amnesty will come from their work as auditors. For the purposes of employing investigators and auditors or continuing such employment for the purposes of increasing enforcement. The department shall prepare a report, April 1, 2005, and February 1 of every year thereafter, detailing the results of the amnesty program in the first year, and the subsequent enforcement efforts of that body of tax compliance...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...infrastructure created with the amnesty's contributions. That will...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.
