Reading bills that follow. Once we get into the Final Reading bills, we will not take up motions for specific amendments during that Final Reading portion. Certainly, if you wish to speak about a bill, you have the opportunity to do that. If you wish to file a motion to strike an enacting clause or something of that nature, certainly you can do that. But if you intend on filing amendments that you want to seriously pursue, I'd encourage you to have them on file so that we can take them up following this next section of bills. Right now, LB 943 and LB 613 from that list of Final Reading bills have proposed amendments filed, and we will take them up. With that, I would ask the Clerk if you have any messages or announcements.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 485, LB 485A, LB 1034, LB 1097, and LB 1097A, all, as correctly engrossed. (Legislative Journal pages 1600-1601.)

SPEAKER BROMM: We will go to LB 439.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 439 on Final Reading, Senator Beutler, first of all I have AM2131, but a note you want to withdraw that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, I now have AM3445, but a similar note to withdraw.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to return LB 439 to Select File for specific amendment, AM3561. (Legislative Journal page 1476.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on your amendment.
