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Capitol Commission, so it was suggested that the State Court Administrator be there in place and to represent the judicial branch of government. So he would be the third head of a separate branch, so to speak, represented on the State Capitol Commission. And then the director of the Historical Society, and the dean of the architecture school are on that commission, and then there would be three additional citizens appointed by the Governor. So that, in a nutshell, is what I hope very much you will approve. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, my light was on for the other bill that was before us, but I do want to second what Senator Beutler has said. And I don't see Senator Hudkins, but I'm grateful that she was willing to allow her bill to be the vehicle. Oh, I see her in front. If I would have used my eye...let me take my eyeglasses off so I can see this lady. It made it possible for us to have a vehicle which, in and of itself, would not alarm anybody, and there would be a more...a greater likelihood that the merits of what was contained in her bill would be looked at, so I'm appreciative of that. And the people that Senator Beutler named did do a lot of work. I didn't have to do much work. All I had to do was indicate what I would like to see in the bill, what I would like to not see in the bill, but as far as the hard work, that was done by others. But I do support the amendment and I will support the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members. I turned my light on in case I had any questions once Senator Beutler was through with his presentation, and I don't have any. I think he's explained it very thoroughly and concisely. And I would like to thank Senator Beutler, because he spent an inordinate amount of time on this and there really were some issues that had to be worked through that were time consuming and serious. And I'll second what Senator Chambers said about Senator Hudkins allowing her bill to be used. And the fact that the security part isn't even still in there, Senator Hudkins,
