And she waives. Question then is the adoption of AM3417 to LB 559. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. Do you have anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 559 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is to advance LB 559 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. We do need to make a slight agenda change and bring LB 559A up for consideration for return for amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Thompson would move to return LB 559A to Select File for AM3525. (Legislative Journal page 1602.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Thompson.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes, Mr. Speaker, this would return the bill to take out \$14,400. So, that was part of the Baker bill and now it will just reflect what is needed for the organ donor registry. These are from the cash funds of DMV.

SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the opening on the return. Any discussion? I see none. Do you wish to close, Senator Thompson? She waives closing. The question then is the return of LB 559A for specific amendment. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.
