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SENATOR FOLEY: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I wonder if Senator Brashear could yield to some questions. I see that he's on the phone. I don't know if he can yield.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Brashear, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Mr. President.

SENATOR FOLEY: Thank you, Senator. I realize this is Senator Mossey's amendment that we're talking about, but I think that the language he's offering us is actually committee amendment language. Is that correct?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: It is not committee amendment language. It's language which was further refined after the committee amendment,...

SENATOR FOLEY: I see.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...between...negotiated between Senator Chambers and I.

SENATOR FOLEY: Okay. But it's...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: And me.

SENATOR FOLEY: I think it fairly closely parallels the basic structure of the committee amendment?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: It does, and it is more restrictive.

SENATOR FOLEY: Okay. Okay.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: It is less expansive and more restrictive in its application.

SENATOR FOLEY: All right. And I did vote for that language in committee.
