review these materials, have said that what we're doing in LB 625 is okay, with the amendment that we adopted the last time. So I would urge you to reject this motion to return to Select File. I really, truly feel that after three times on Final Reading, it's only fair that I get a vote on this bill. And if you are compelled by the arguments other than the materials that have been provided to you by...about what HUD's position is and what the NEOC's position is, if you're compelled, then vote against the bill. But at this point in time, I just think that we need to get a vote on the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brown. Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, I give my time to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you have almost five minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, while we're talking about being accurate, I would like Senator Brown to show any reference in this HUD letter that is included in what I gave you of a reference to LB 625, saying that what LB 625 is attempting to do is all right. There is no reference to that. What this HUD letter deals with is an opinion written by the Nebraska Attorney General. And there are concerns expressed about the Nebraska Attorney General's letter, or his opinion, wherein he indicated, or left it open, that maybe conciliation information would be made public, when according to HUD rules and regulations, that cannot be made public. If you read the HUD letter, dated October 6, 2003, you'll see it's talking about the Attorney General's Opinion, nothing about LB 625. There is nothing in any letter that I handed out to the body in this package where Senator Brown is accused of anything. I gave Larry Bare a copy of a letter, so he could see the name of an individual he could call. I gave a copy of that letter only to Senator Schimek and to Senator Wehrbein, and I told them both to disregard everything in that letter.
