SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Brown. Senator Brown waives. There are no further lights. It is your motion, Senator Brown. Do you wish to close? Waives closing. The question before the body is whether LB 625 shall be returned to Select File for FA1689. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: The bill is returned. Senator Brown, you're recognized on FA1689.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, I would just remind everyone that the sooner we vote on this, the sooner we get to go party.
