I think Senator Redfield said it more succinctly, and that is, there is a plan out there that you can follow. You don't need...we don't need to hire somebody in the state to manage this plan. I think that's the bottom line. With that, I'm going to vote against the bill, and I hope you do too. And with that, thank you, Mr. President. I will withdraw the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Madam Clerk, LB 37.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 37 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 37 pass? All in favor of the motion vote aye; those opposed to the motion vote nay. The question before the body is LB 37. Have you all voted who care to? Senator Price, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR PRICE: Senator Cudaback, are all members present in the house? Could I have a call of the house and a roll call vote, please?

SENATOR CUDABACK: We are on Final Reading, Senator Price.

SENATOR PRICE: Okay. Thank you. Would everybody...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Everybody check...

SENATOR PRICE: Would everybody...would you have them check in, please?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Everybody check in, please.

SENATOR PRICE: Yes. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Price. All members please check in, as we are on Final Reading. All members are present. Mr. Clerk, call the roll on the question, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1638.)
