ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title of LB 479.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 479E pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. (Visitors introduced.) Record please, Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1650-1651.) The vote is 47 ayes, 1 nay, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 479E, with the emergency clause attached, passes. Madam Clerk, LB 692.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 692 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 692 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion who care to? Record please, Madam Clerk. I'm sorry.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1651-1652.) The vote is 46 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.
