character, that would be able to provide us the necessary oversight on the Game and Parks Commission. And I would encourage your adoption of his confirmation. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. Any further discussion? Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I would, just as a side note, say that at the present time, two of the members of the Game and Parks Commission have to be involved in agriculture. And come 19... come 2006, at least three members have to be involved in agriculture, and two of them live on a farm. So he would fulfill one of those requirements.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is the confirmation report offered by the Natural Resources be adopted. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal pages 1665-1666.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report offered by the Natural Resources Committee.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The report has been adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next report is by the Transportation Committee, involves appointments to the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, as Chairman of that committee, you're recognized to open on the report.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. We have three appointments to confirm this morning for the Motor Vehicle Licensing Board. There are two new appointments. Both those people did appear in person at the hearing. The first one is Sid Dillon, from Fremont, Senator Janssen's district. He is currently serving as president, Dillon Brothers Harley-Davidson. There is a requirement on the Motor Vehicles Licensing Board we have one person representing motorcycle sales. He fulfills that requirement. He's a longtime dealer in the Fremont area. The second new appointment is Douglas Rolfsmeier, from Seward. He
