the tax amnesty program, which I think is a significant bill as well. And all in all you passed about 136 bills with about 75 more amended into those bills. And two years ago we actually passed 123, and four years ago we passed 152. So I don't care how people want to measure it, you did, you did great work. But we'd always like to do more. We're always disappointed when we can't get something done that we'd like to do, but for many...for many of us there's another year and another time, and I think issues will come and go and we'll survive, those of us who are here or not here, and they will be taken care of. I'm very, very confident of that. So I commend you on a great session and I would like to thank you for your cooperation and your personal sacrifice over the last several years we've had budget problems, personal sacrifice of time, personal sacrifice of issues for which there will be more time another day. I would like to offer you an applause and a congratulations. (Applause) With that, Mr. President, who I thank on the record for having been dutifully responsible and efficient standing in as Speaker Pro Tem many, many times, Senator Cudaback, I address you...
