SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our senator acting as chaplain this morning is Senator Price. Senator Price.

SENATOR PRICE: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Price, for serving in that capacity. We appreciate it. I call the third day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please check in.
