Pursuant to its introduction, I have a communication from the Speaker, directing LR 23 be referred to Reference Committee for purposes of conducting a public hearing. LR 24CA, by Senator Raikes, proposes an amendment to Article VII, Section 5, and Article VII, Section 7, of the Nebraska Constitution. LR 25CA, by Senator Smith, proposes an amendment to Article XI, Section 6, of the Nebraska Constitution.
