SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. On with discussion. Senator Chambers, you may continue.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Friend and I had discussions about my views, my very negative and harsh views about this country's policies in dealing not only with Iraq but Afghanistan and the Middle East, and my strong criticisms of George Bush, whom I consider to be a war criminal. If Hitler was one, Bush is no less a one. Why is not Bush in the dock? Because the only ones who wind up in the dock charged with crimes are the losers. That's why. When America and the so-called Allied Forces firebombed Dresden in Germany, that was a war crime. Dresden was not a military target. The Nazi military had been virtually defeated. The Nazi regime had collapsed. The city was inhabited by civilians, but America, Britain, the most civilized countries, supposedly, on the face of the earth committed war crimes then, but they were never called to account, and they won't be called to account in this instance. But the country is becoming increasingly isolated, as it should. I wish international Communism had not collapsed. When America was trying to compete for the world against the Soviet powers, America wanted to put up the pretense that there was freedom, justice, and equality in this country, and black people and other minority groups made more progress when Communism was raging than at any other time, because America, in its hypocrisy, wanted to pretend that the constitution really was applied in this country. I wish as much effort was put forth to ensure that black people can vote in elections in this country as was put forth to try to ensure that Iraqis could vote in Iraq. I wish they would let some of us vote in other countries and have our votes counted in this country, so that our votes would be counted, in the way they're letting Iraqis vote in other countries. But that's what happens when a hypocritical outfit that wants to consider itself the moral leader of the
