SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Chambers, you're asking the Chair to get Senator Janssen for a question, is that right?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Janssen, would you answer a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Janssen, is this bill going to have an A bill?

SENATOR JANSSEN: It probably will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, either it will or it won't. Is it your plan to submit an A bill?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, yes. We're going to need some more money to use the 100 percent.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you plan to submit (laugh) an A bill with this bill?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Absolutely.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Because if you don't, well, there's no assurance that the A bill will pass, is there?

SENATOR JANSSEN: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There is no more guarantee that this money is going to be forthcoming than there is that the federal money that these people complain about not being there will be forthcoming. Is that correct?

SENATOR JANSSEN: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Members of the Legislature, this is an emotional bill. That's all it is, pure and simple. It is not a justified expenditure of money. I'm going to fight it here and I will fight it whenever it shows its
