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SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes. I...if you'll carry on a little bit,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...I'll get that figure.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The question that I put to Senator Janssen, which he is going to track down an answer for, is whether or not he has the amount at his fingertips that this program is receiving now by way of appropriation.

SENATOR JANSSEN: About \$825,000, as of last year.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then you would ask for \$825,000 in your A bill?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, if that's where the strength...that was at 75 percent, Senator Chambers. So you'd have to add another 25 percent...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, you...

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...to that and use the same number.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, you don't, because this doesn't say 100 percent. This doesn't say 75 percent.

SENATOR JANSSEN: It says up to 100 percent. But first that would have to be...the money, what we would think would be available. Say it would cover 85 percent of the...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then you're going to try...

SENATOR JANSSEN: It would be flexible.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You're going to try to put in an A bill an amount that would fund at 100 percent the number of people who currently are enrolled under this program.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Right.
