these preliminary little skirmishes like we're having here today. Senator Janssen has gotten as much mileage out of this thing as he can. He has tried to say, do something for the people in Iraq. But there is nothing in this bill, and as it's written, there's less here now than there was before. But people don't read these bills. They don't know what's in it. They don't even know what we're voting on now when we vote to move it. But I know. And I don't lose my concentration, and I don't lose my ability to keep in mind several things at the same time. Because what we're dealing with is not that complicated, as far as I'm concerned. But a bill like this, if it moves, puts a complicating factor into whatever else happens...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...this session. Since we have a new sheriff in town, this bill may not be getting as much time, from now on, as it's getting today. It's going nowhere. There's nothing in it. It does nothing. It does less than what the current law does. This is one of those George Patton-esque escapades. This is one of those George Patton-esque escapades. A whole lot of noise and bravado and people going here, people going there; when it's over, things are worse than they ever were before, and they finally say, that man is...he's got a mental problem.
