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unorthodox. Unorthodox nature and passion is what won the day. I haven't seen anything unorthodox today at all, except some of Erdman's comments, and those are off the record. So how much time, sir? (Laugh) That's all I'll have, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: None.

SENATOR FRIEND: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Thank you, Senator Friend.
Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Chambers, this constitutional amendment is okay with your amendment, it's okay without. Either way works for me. Will I vote to reconsider? If you want me to, I will. If you want your name off of it, I'll vote to reconsider. It's fine without it. I probably shouldn't say this before lunch, but have you ever come upon a mama cow and her calf, and the calf is partly eaten but it's still alive? One of the biggest...one of the biggest predators we have in this state is the coyote and every year we always have a couple calves that don't have any tail because the coyotes got to it before the mama cow could fend the coyote off. Coyotes are something that we need to control in this state. I don't hate coyotes. They're fine. Matter of fact, my sons enjoy hunting them. I have neighbors who have dogs that run them down and kill them. They're greyhounds. I've been with them on the hunts. Yes, it seems rather vicious, but if I'm a coyote, I'd rather die that way than the ones in southeast Nebraska that have mange and don't have any hair on them. They'll freeze to death in the wintertime. There's a lot worse ways to die than by the hands of a hunter or trapper, and Mother Nature is not kind. But we try to protect our calves and coyotes are a predator. I had a neighbor who had a friend who does this for the pelts and for the sport, whatever it is. Wanted somebody to trap coyotes in his pasture about five years ago, and my neighbor thought, well, there's probably not too many coyotes down there. He trapped over 100 coyotes that winter and three-fourths of them were females, all who were going to have litters of six to eight, even up to ten pups. Coyotes are prolific. You're not going to
