four-footed, two-footed. There are more pregnant women...or pregnant women, more of them die from murder than any other cause in this country. They're helpless. So we don't talk about protecting the woman. We talk about protecting a fetus. My standards are different from the standards of the people on this floor, and my view is different from the view of the people on this floor. What Senator Friend asked, which I think went over the heads of most of my colleagues because they don't want to confront it, is this thing even necessary? With all the people standing up on this floor, blubbering almost about you must save hunting, we got to fish; good God, don't talk about take trapping from me; you're going to take my trapping; oh, how can I live without trapping? What will I tell my son? Son, you can't use those traps to catch the coyote by the foot and tear his foot off or let him get infected. You can't do that anymore. And the little boy will say, oh, Daddy, why can't I do that? Because those mean people said that trapping is cruel. So they go home and cry about they can't trap. How many of you all think a Legislature is going to outlaw trapping? contempt as I have for trappers, as much foolishness and cruelty that I see in hunting, nobody can show where I ever brought a bill to try to abolish either one of them. You're not going to get a Legislature to do that, so you're going to let some man in Minnesota make fools of you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: This state is not going to ban trapping, hunting and fishing, and if you think so, you need to go take some medication because you've got some chemical imbalances in your brain because your mind is not functioning. And if it's not necessary, why do you want to befoul your constitution, your constitution? How does it hurt me or my people if you act foolish and put silliness into your constitution? Not at all. It gives me something to talk about on my weekly television program. Look what these white people are doing. How many of you, black brothers and sisters, think that in Nebraska they're going to ban hunting and fishing and trapping? That's what they give their time to. That's what they go around collecting That's what they're proud of, because some signatures for. hunters and fishers and anglers came to Omaha and put on a road
