But I really do get kind of tired of listening to Omaha senators trying to tell us how to run problems out in the western end of the state when they have very seldom been out there. You should go out there and look at the situation before you start making big decisions and then start screaming to the heavens that we're being very dishonest with the taxpayer and we're dumping everything on the local people and the state of Nebraska should be responsible because they're supposed to own all the wild animals, which, as far as I know, we've checked with the Game and Parks, they do own all the wild Some of them they have a control over and, if you'll notice, it's usually those that have some type of revenue base But they are the ones that they've always had with them. control of that sort of stuff so there's no point in trying to change the laws or that sort of thing.
