SPEAKER BRASHEAR: Senator Schrock, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I would like to have a call of the house and a roll call vote in reverse order, please.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: You have heard the motion. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: Members, the house is under call. Only authorized personnel should remain on the floor. Absent members not excused should report to the Chamber. Please check in. The house is under call. Would Senators Raikes, Foley, Mines, Preister, Thompson, and Bourne please report to the Chamber. Senator Preister, please report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Thank you. Members, we are voting on Senator Schrock's motion to invoke cloture. He has requested a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1280.)
36 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to invoke cloture, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Members, cloture has been invoked. Senator Chambers' FA41 is now before you. All those in favor signify by voting aye. Senator Schrock, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I'd like a roll call vote in regular order.
