SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: All in favor of the house going under call, vote aye; opposed, nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Raikes, Senator Kruse, Senator Foley. Senator Raikes, the house is under call. All members are present or accounted for.
