SENATOR SMITH: It does reinstate that. That's part of the amendment. There's more to the amendment, but actually I intend to withdraw this amendment and submit the next one.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, you're going to withdraw this and submit a different one?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, then I will not discuss this one. I will put my light on for the next one.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Smith, you're recognized.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President. At the beginning of my time, I would like to withdraw FA182 and replace that with AM1312.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're asking for a substitution?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes, if that's necessary, but I don't believe it's necessary. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any objection? Seeing none, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR SMITH: It's the next one in line.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator, you're withdrawing FA182. The next amendment I have pending to Senator Jensen's amendment is AM1312, offered by Senator Smith. (Legislative Journal pages 1288-1289.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, to open on AM1312.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I am proposing, through AM1312, to remove the relaxation of the helmet law in terms of who must wear a helmet, who must not, or must...not be required to, and it would...the thrust of AM1312
