SENATOR SMITH: Reverse order, please.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: A roll call vote in reverse order has been requested. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1289-1290.) 28 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment to the amendment.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The amendment to the amendment is adopted. Members, we will now proceed to vote on AM1289 by Senator Jensen. Senator Smith, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SMITH: A point of order.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: State your point.

SENATOR SMITH: That AM1289 is...takes the form of the last amendment. Is that in order? The last amendment becomes AM1289.
