SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Take it up.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith is taking the bill up. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your motion to indefinitely postpone.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I'd like to ask Senator Smith a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, would you yield to a question from Senator Chambers?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It did not replace the Jensen amendment?

SENATOR SMITH: Excuse me, it did, Senator Chambers, it did.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It replaced all of it.
