of the ingredients necessary to make meth. And if it means going to Schedule V, as Senator Bourne and I talked about, requiring a prescription to get cold medicine, I think that's a reasonable step. If it means we do a logbook or an electronic version of a logbook, or whatever is necessary, I don't think we can go too far in the protection of the citizens of the state of Nebraska. So I thank you, Mr. President, and return the balance of my time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Flood. Senator Aguilar on the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR AGUILAR: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I want to totally agree with one of the things Senator Chambers said, and that is the need to expand treatment in Nebraska, and also the educational piece that Senator Engel talked about. Right now we're doing that, we're doing that. And do we need to expand on it? Absolutely yes. It's totally necessary. Right now we have drug courts in Nebraska, and we're working to expand them all over the state. That is a treatment program. It doesn't lock people up. Doesn't...we don't feel it does any good to lock people up. I couldn't agree more with Senator Chambers on that point. We have to get these people treatment, and we as a body need to find ways to do that more effectively, and all throughout the state of Nebraska. One of the other things Senator Chambers talked about that I found interesting, when he was talking about sexual performance while you're on methamphetamine, most of the studies that I've looked at actually says it causes impotence. So it's a little different take on it. And the other thing that's importance is the addiction of this drug. The addiction of this drug causes one to not allow one to experience pleasure the way most people do. The only pleasure that they know is the high, the extreme high from methamphetamine. Nothing else matters. They derive no pleasure from hugging their child, absolutely none. That's critical about this. That's why we need to do something. He also talked about this being a big splash for senators to get their names in the paper. That's not true. Senator, this is not a big splash. This is dipping our toe in the water. This is just the start of what we need to do, and whatever little bit we do will help this problem, help it immensely. We have to
