CLERK: 23 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The house is under call. Would all members please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all personnel...unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. The house is under call. The house is under call. Would all senators please return to the Chamber. Senator Stuhr, Senator Heidemann, please check in. Senator Janssen, Senator Cudaback. Is that correct, Senator Chambers? The question is the adoption of AM1379 to the Appropriations Committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Roll call vote.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: There has been a request for a roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1391.)  
19 ayes, 10 nays, Madam President, on the amendment.
