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will help us create jobs. Maybe we're just eternal optimists. But I do believe that it will help us create jobs. You've heard me many times talk about the Call...Child Support Call Center in Wausa. That was 30 jobs. And it was unbelievable. They had a hundred and some applicants for those There are people to fill the jobs. There are young people that want to stay in rural Nebraska. We have one of my schools in Creighton, sitting right upstairs in the balcony. I'm sure many of them would stay in rural Nebraska if they had a job to come back to. And the problem we have is creating jobs. And we need to do it a little different than the business incentive plans that we have in the rest of the state. It just requires something different. We have to encourage people. We have to have leadership programs. And that's one of the things that this bill will do. So I very much believe in this bill. I did agree, as you heard, with Senator Beutler, we should have a sunset date on it that will sunset with the rest of the business incentives. I'm very much in favor of that. I'm quite certain the bill will be productive. But if it isn't, it should end. And if it is, I'm sure it will be extended after that. So with that, I think I will return my time. But I would very much appreciate your support on this division. And Senator Chambers, I thank you for your willingness to work with me on that. we do appreciate it. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Cunningham and Senator Wehrbein. You've heard the opening on the second portion of the divided Wehrbein amendment, which was AM1346. Open for discussion. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I said before, fair is fair. Since this program is going to go, I think it should be given more than a pittance. The reason, when the bill was standing on its own, or attempting to do so, I wanted to cut the money, was to show that if this is all you're going to give, you're not even giving enough money to accomplish any of the purposes. So I want to make an offer to Senator Cunningham.
