ASSISTANT CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 mays on the adoption of the Chambers amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment has been adopted. Anything further on the committee amendments, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Back to discussion of AM0249, known as the committee amendments to LB 90. Seeing no lights on, Senator Landis, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. The committee amendments would then become the bill. It winds up merging in the agenda of value-added agriculture and the leadership programs that Senator Cunningham has supported this year, along with a long-term ethanol plan with General Fund money and an eighth of a cent checkoff.
