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pair of mittens and a pair of shoes, they can now buy one mitten and one shoe, these little businesses? If that?

SENATOR CONNEALY: Maybe one pair of hunting boots and one backpack.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Could they give them a cup so that they could go beg on the corner? You...that meets with your approval, huh? Old Senator Connealy. I told him I'd call him Ichabod. That means "the glory has departed." Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You may continue, Senator Chambers. It will be your third time, as you know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. And it got here awfully quickly. This bill requires contemplation. And I need some more time. We're at 5:34. I need enough time to get us to 6:00. I'd like to ask Senator Stuthman a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuthman.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Stuthman, have you spoken three times on this?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: I think I've spoken twice.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Were you...

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Once? Jeepers, that's not too bad.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So you have two more times. Would you share one of them with me?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: I would be glad to do that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. And I will finish my time now. I do want to get us until 6:00, which is what I promised. And then tomorrow we will deal with the budget bills. And if we
