CLERK: Mr. President, in addition to the new bills, new resolutions: LR 245 by Senator Howard, asking the Legislature recognize the service of Peter Hoagland to the people of the state of Nebraska; LR 246, a resolution by Senator Fischer, asking the Legislature to be...congratulate the members of the Stuart High School mock trial team; LR 247 by Senator Fischer, congratulating the Sargent High School football team; LR 248 by Senator Fischer, congratulating Katelyn White on their success in the Class C girls' competition; LR 249 by Senator Fischer, congratulating Ainsworth High School girls' cross country team; LR 250 by Senator Smith, asking the Legislature to declare February 6, 2006, as Ronald Reagan Day in Nebraska; LR 251 by Senator Smith, encouraging the Legislature to urge Congress, members of the Nebraska congressional delegation, to support, work to pass, and vote for the immediate and permanent repeal of the death tax; LR 252 by Senator Smith, urging the Nebraska Legislature to urge members of the congressional delegation to restore, protect, and enhance intellectual and physical property rights in present federal law, pending federal legislation and all trade agreements; LR 253 is a constitutional amendment by Senator Carol Hudkins, a bill to propose an amendment to Article VII, Section 18 of the Nebraska Constitution; LR 254 is
