SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. I call the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, second day...our chaplain of the day is Reverend Steven Plank, Central Presbyterian Church, Omaha, Senator Howard's district. Reverend, please.

PASTOR PLANK: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Reverend Plank, for being with us this morning. Now I call the second day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please record your presence. (Doctor of the day introduced.) Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: (Read corrections, Legislative Journal page 157.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, a Reference report referring LB 764-859. Constitutional amendments LR 253 and LR 254CA have been referenced, as have a number of gubernatorial appointees, those reports all signed by Senator Engel, as Chairperson of the Executive Board.
