SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, I would withdraw that amendment and any subsequent amendments that I have.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, the next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment, Senator Chambers, FA229.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment, FA229.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, there are gremlins in the machine, so I'm not going to take my amendment. I will ask to pass over it and the next one...

SENATOR CUDABACK: So ordered.

SENATOR CUDABACK: FA231 was also withdrawn, Senator Beutler. Mr. Clerk, next amendment.

CLERK: Senator Chambers, I'm back to your third amendment. Senator, do you want to...

CLERK: ...pass that over? Then at this point, Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Further discussion, Revenue Committee amendments themselves? Senator Chambers, you're recognized.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, we're plunging headlong through the thicket and we'll probably wind up on the other side in the swamp.
