SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that is what your amendment to the committee amendment had done, basically.

SENATOR BURLING: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The rest of the committee amendment stands as it would appear when it came from the committee,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BURLING: Well,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...as far as telling what this commission is supposed to do?

SENATOR BURLING: Yes, that doesn't change. What they're charged with doing hasn't changed.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now, Senator Burling, if this committee amendment as amended by your amendment, is adopted, we get rid of the green copy altogether.

SENATOR BURLING: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what we will have left is the committee amendment, as amended by your amendment.

SENATOR BURLING: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Who drafted the green copy, if you know?

SENATOR BURLING: Well, I did.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did you have some assistance?

SENATOR BURLING: Well, very little.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Does the committee amendment change the green copy quite a bit?
