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SENATOR COMBS: Yes. There...I can check and get back with you and get an answer to you for that.

SENATOR THOMPSON: So there is someone here to answer these questions?

SENATOR COMBS: Yes.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. We will...

SENATOR COMBS: There's two...

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...take another look and try to find them.

SENATOR COMBS: ...two representatives. Yeah. There's two representatives from the State Patrol that probably can answer that better than me.

SENATOR THOMPSON: That are in the lobby?

SENATOR COMBS: They're in this corner up here on this end. They're not in...

SENATOR THOMPSON: Oh, they're not standing behind the glass?

SENATOR COMBS: On this side, they're up here, by the lounge.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay. I will...we will check on that.

SENATOR COMBS: Yeah.

SENATOR THOMPSON: And that...and the other question I also have is how we define "currently adjudged mentally incompetent," how the State Patrol would be able to know that. And then the person, if they come under any of these conditions, are supposed to turn in their permit, which I think, for this population, might not be...might be a little more difficult.

PRESIDENT SHEEHY: One minute.

SENATOR THOMPSON: And so how you revoke this permit should
