instead, they just deal with the peace officer. The emergency service personnel has dropped out of the picture, because of sloppy, slapdash, careless drafting. All they want is something passed. They don't care what it does. They don't care what it does not do, but I do. This is atrocious, but the body doesn't care. So you're going to give the NRA a vote as a favor for cloture, from what I've been told. And Senator Erdman showed me an article in the Lincoln Journal Star where it was the local yokel who said that they've counted votes and they have enough for cloture, and it just mentioned that the guy from around Washington is also here from the NRA. But I say they're in it together, aiding and abetting. If one pulls the robbery and another drives the getaway car, they're equally guilty. This is an NRA bill and we know it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And there's a lot in it that nobody on the floor knows because they haven't read it. Why do I say nobody, including me? Because my concept of reading means to understand what you perceive when you go over those words, and I do not understand everything in this bill. A lot of it makes no sense whatsoever. So my motion is to recommit this bill to the Judiciary Committee. Mr. President, I will ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.
